As a key member of your high school athletics program, St. John's certified athletic trainers (ATC) are highly educated and skilled health care professionals. Working in cooperation with physicians, school athletics administrators, coaches and parents, your ATC will be onsite to help prevent, assess, treat, and provide basic rehabilitation of injuries.

St. John's Sports Medicine athletic trainers provide your school with 25-30 hours of practice and event coverage each week. In the event an athlete is injured during practice or a game, the ATC will be there to evaluate the injury, provide immediate care when needed, and communicate directly with you. We are there to assist you and your student athlete in an effective and efficient management strategy for a fast but safe return back to athletic activity.
